# Foundation CSS Framework

Zurb's Foundation framework

<http://foundation.zurb.com/index.html> provides the web developer with a structured set of css classes that makes it easier to design a useable webpage for various platforms (Mobile, Tablet, Laptops).

## 5 Classes to Remember

- ▶ Row - Horizontal container for vertical columns
- ▶ Column - Columns hold elements. Total should sum to 12
- ▶ Small-# - Specifies the number of columns the element should occupy on a small (mobile) screen.
- ▶ Medium-# - Specifies the number of columns the element should occupy on a medium (tablet) screen.
- ▶ Large-# - Specifies the number of columns the element should occupy on a large (laptop) screen.
